

## Group Visits Information & Booking Form

The museum welcomes group visits from schools, Scouting/Guiding groups, other young people's groups along with all other interested parties.

Enjoy a great day out exploring our unique collection of military and civil aircraft and cockpit sections, together with indoor displays showcasing Norfolk's aviation history. School groups from primary school age upwards may like to plan a visit as part of their study of the Second World War, military history, engineering or the mechanics of flight.

For an additional price of £2.50 for adults and £1.50 for children, pre-booked groups will have the option of booking on the day a hands-on guided tour inside one of our aircraft; normally our Nimrod MR2 maritime patrol aircraft, Avro RJ85 Airliner OR the Vulcan Cold War bomber.

Visits through the museum are self-guided, although volunteers are available to interpret exhibits and answer questions. Personalised tours or talks may be available by special request.

Facilities include free coach parking, toilets (including accessible and baby change facilities), a gift shop and tea room. Hot and cold drinks and snacks are available for purchase.

Groups are welcome to bring their own lunches to enjoy either indoors or at our outdoor picnic area, which offers views of aircraft flying from Norwich International Airport.

It is recommended that you allow 2-4 hours for a full visit.

Admission rates are £3.00 per child (includes children under 8). Adults are responsible for children at all times during the visit. We recommend that one adult be in attendance for every five children, this adult will be admitted without charge.

Admission for adult groups, seniors (over 60) and students are charged at £1 discount on the published entry charge per person.

**Please note the minimum group size to qualify for this reduced group rate within museum opening hours is 10 persons.**

We accept payment by cash, card or cheque. Cheques should be made payable to 'The City of Norwich Aviation Museum'.

Group visits may be held throughout the year, any time the museum is open however, it is helpful if you are able to plan your visit for a Wednesday.
